The chords in the above table are arranged by key. The same chord may appear in up to 3 different keys, e.g. the chord D is 'I' in the key of D major; 'V' in G major and 'IV' in A major.

You can also use this table to change the key in which you play a song or a tune. For example, if you know that a song is in C and the first few chords are C, F, G7 & C (I, IV, V & I), you can 'transpose' the song into G major by playing the corresponding chords in that key - G, C, D7 & G.
